MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

Thursday, February 8, 2018 ♦ 6:00 p.m.

1. CALL TO ORDER

With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 6:01p.m. by Chairman Shoemaker.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion made by Cynthia DeSiena, seconded by Marti Rich, to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of January 11, 2018. Motion passed.

3. REPORTS

A. Chair

1. Chairman Shoemaker reported that she met with City Manager, Dr. Brenda Fettrow, and Planning Director, Alix Bernard, about proposed projects, including the Don Griffin Walking Trail entrance, Thompson House beautification, trash cans at SCAT bus stop locations, and Old St. Mary's fence beautification.

B. Beautification

Chairman Shoemaker recommended that trash cans be placed at SCAT bus stops throughout the City. Member Liz Lark-Riley suggested that they should be accessible for the disabled.

Chairman Shoemaker recommended the beautification of the Thompson House without using actual landscaping due to lack of irrigation and sun at the facility. Chairman Shoemaker also mentioned updating the handrails and using graphic wraps on the exterior of the sides of the building, similar to what the City of Cocoa does with their traffic light boxes.

Several members felt that maintaining the historic character of the Thompson House was important.

Chairman Shoemaker suggested involving the community in the design of the graphic wrap/mural and perhaps partnering with the Brevard Cultural Alliance.

Chairman Shoemaker asked if any board members would volunteer for a subcommittee for the Thompson House Beautification Project. Members Crystal Pope and Cynthia DeSiena volunteered.

A meeting with subcommittee members and Staff will be scheduled.

Chairman Shoemaker stated the City will be installing a fence at the Old St. Mary's church and suggested having a spring planting after the fence has been installed.

Chairman Shoemaker stated she will be meeting with City Manager Fettrow periodically about these beautification projects.

Chairman Shoemaker stated there is one vacancy on the board.

Liz Lark-Riley mentioned that Rockledge Gardens is interested in partnering with the City on planting trees around the playground at Larry L. Schultz Park. Ms. Lark-Riley will gather a list of approved trees and a cost estimate for the March meeting.
