

## Volunteer Boards & Committees

### Board of Adjustment

Seven members and two alternates appointed by City Council that:

- ◆ Make determinations when it is alleged there is an error in an order, requirement, or decision made by an administrative official in the enforcement of a zoning ordinance or regulation
- ◆ Decide special exceptions
- ◆ Decide requests for variances
- ◆ Meet monthly, third Tuesday, 6:30 p.m.

### Board of Adjustment & Appeals

Five members appointed by City Council that:

- ◆ Hear appeals of decisions and interpretations of the Building Official
- ◆ Consider variances of the technical codes
- ◆ Meet as needed

### Business Development Committee

Eleven members appointed by City Council that are responsible for:

- ◆ Implementing a strategic plan for a long-range program of business and industrial growth
- ◆ Educating the community on the need for increased business and industry
- ◆ Meet last Tuesday each month, 5:30 p.m.

### Citizens Advisory Committee

Seven members appointed by City Council that:

- ◆ Encourage, promote and solicit citizen participation in projects being executed by the Planning Department
- ◆ Meet the second Monday of the month (as needed), 7 p.m.

### Citizens Recreation Advisory Board

Seven members appointed by City Council that:

- ◆ Advise City Council on all matters pertaining to public recreation
- ◆ Meet bi-monthly, third Thursday, 6 p.m.

### Code Enforcement Board

Seven members appointed by City Council that:

- ◆ Impose administrative fines and other penalties to provide an expeditious method of enforcing the Code and Ordinances of the City of Rockledge
- ◆ Meet the second Thursday of each month (as needed), 4:30 p.m.

### Community Redevelopment Agency Board of Commissioners

Seven members appointed by City Council that:

- ◆ Execute community redevelopment projects and related activities within the prescribed areas of operation under Section 16-19, Rockledge Code of Ordinances
- ◆ Meet monthly, fourth Wednesday, 5:30 p.m.

### Education Advisory Committee

Seven members appointed by City Council that:

- ◆ Advise Council on matters related to educational facilities located within the City limits and their impact on traffic, delivery of services and general growth patterns
- ◆ Meet quarterly, or as directed by City Council

### Fire Employees Retirement Board

Five elected or appointed members that:

- ◆ Manage the Retirement Plan for Fire Department employees, specifically matters regarding the trust agreement and trust fund
- ◆ Meet quarterly (Feb., May, Aug., Nov.) on the third Thursday (9 a.m.)

### General Employees Retirement Board

Five appointed members that:

- ◆ Manage the Retirement Plan for City employees, specifically matters regarding the trust agreement and trust fund
- ◆ Meet quarterly (Feb., May, Aug., Nov.) on the third Thursday (1 p.m.)

### Police Employees Retirement Board

Five appointed or elected members that:

- ◆ Manage the Retirement Plan for Police Department employees, specifically matters regarding the trust agreement and trust fund
- ◆ Meet quarterly (Feb., May, Aug., Nov.) on the third Thursday (3 p.m.)

### Planning Commission

Nine members appointed by City Council that:

- ◆ Engage in matters related to zoning uses and development of land uses
- ◆ Establish principles, objectives and policies for the planned use and development of land
- ◆ Review and make recommendations for special exceptions to the Board of Adjustment
- ◆ Review and make recommendations for zoning and comprehensive plan amendments
- ◆ Meet monthly, first Tuesday, 6 p.m.

### The Rockledge Environmental Enhancement (T.R.E.E.) Board

Up to 10 members appointed by City Council that:

- ◆ Encourage the planting and preservation of trees, shrubs, plants and flowers
- ◆ Promote public interest in the general improvement of the appearance of the City
- ◆ Meet monthly, second Thursday, 6 p.m.
