SUBJECT: SOFTWARE SUBSCRIPTION FOR WEBSITE PDF ACCESSIBILITY COMPLIANCE, DOCACCESS

BACKGROUND: Government agencies, including the City of Rockledge, are facing a critical deadline for PDF accessibility compliance for public-facing websites, per a recent Department of Justice (DOJ) ruling. While the City has made great strides in its compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) concerning public-facing digital content, DocAccess would ensure that the City complies with ADA guidelines and the DOJ ruling by meeting WCAG 2.1 AA standards for all PDF documents, providing equal access to information for all users, avoiding costly lawsuits and compliance penalties, and serving our residents with disabilities as well as those that do not speak English.

DocAccess will afford the City the opportunity to regularly post additional documentation on the website (such as complete agenda packets and Community Development applications) without the tedious and time-consuming process of manually remediating documents. As the WCAG guidelines are updated and adopted, DocAccess will immediately apply those standards to our website content, resulting in consistent compliance for our digital content.
