2. INVOCATION

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- Regular Meeting on August 16, 2023

Councilwoman Martin moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on August 16, 2023; seconded by Councilman Cadore. The motion carried unanimously (6).

Councilman Cadore introduced members of the Space Coast Hurricane Theater on Ice Corp. The team, whose home rink is Space Coast Iceplex in Rockledge, recently won a national skating competition in Michigan, which qualified the team to compete in France in April 2024. Additionally, the team has been invited to compete in the next national competition in Indiana.

1. Mayoral Proclamation

a. National Suicide Prevention Month

Deputy Mayor Forester read aloud a Proclamation recognizing September 2023 as National Suicide Prevention Month. The Proclamation was received by Donna Bishop, Vice President of Operations, Space Coast Health Foundation. Ms. Bishop thanked the Council for their support of this cause and shared statistics on suicide rates in Florida and in Brevard County.

7. PUBLIC HEARINGS / ORDINANCES / RESOLUTIONS

Vice Chairman Forester explained that the budget process takes several months and consists of significant work from staff, the Council Finance and Budget Committee, and City Council.

At this time, Vice Chairman Forester declared the matter open to the public for comment. There being no public comment, Vice Chairman Forester declared the public hearing to be closed.

B. Public Hearing

& Resolution: Resolution Establishing Recomputed Proposed Millage Rate

Councilman Daski offered a Resolution entitled "A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RECOMPUTED PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR 2023 AD VALOREM TAXES IN THE CITY OF ROCKLEDGE, AND

PUBLICLY ANNOUNCING THE PERCENTAGE INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAXES TENTATIVELY ADOPTED BY THE ROCKLEDGE CITY COUNCIL” **and moved to read the Resolution in its entirety and to open the matter for public hearing; seconded by Councilwoman Martin. The motion passed by unanimous vote (6).**

City Attorney Miniclier read aloud the Resolution utilizing a millage rate of 5.55. Vice Chairman Forester then declared the matter to be open to the public for comment. There being no public comment, Vice Chairman Forester declared the public hearing to be closed.

12. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Action Item: Proposed City Council Meeting Schedule for Calendar Year 2024 (City Clerk)

City Clerk & Public Relations Officer LeVasseur indicated that, per Ordinance, by December 31st of each year, City Council must adopt a schedule of regular meetings for the following calendar year. If the proposed schedule is approved, a Resolution will be drafted for adoption by City Council at a subsequent meeting.

City Manager Fettrow explained that the Public Safety Department is requesting authorization to construct an eight-foot wall around Public Safety headquarters to create and maintain privacy at said location. The wall would replace the current fence.

He reported that he recently met with City Manager Fettrow and Planning Director Cooper about the potential of entering into an agreement with Brevard County for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to pave Palmdale Avenue. Mr. Griffin reported that the City has not received this type of grant since 2009. Mr. Griffin requested assistance with the construction of the roadway and reported that Doug Baldwin is willing to donate \$135,000.00 in land to Brevard County or its designee to help. Mr. Griffin also asserted that Mr. Baldwin believes that Brevard County owes the City some funding.

City Manager Fettrow reported that a meeting has been set up with Brevard County to further discuss the possibility of pursuing a Community Development Block Grant.
