

ORDINANCE NO. 1542 - 2010

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROCKLEDGE, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE III, OF THE ROCKLEDGE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHANGING THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY GOVERNING BODY FROM ROCKLEDGE CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS TO A SEVEN MEMBER INDEPENDENT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS; PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE ORIGINAL INDEPENDENT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS BY THE ROCKLEDGE CITY COUNCIL; ESTABLISHING SUBSEQUENT ELECTION SCHEDULES; DECLARING THAT INVALIDITY OF ANY PORTION HEREOF SHALL NOT AFFECT THE REMAINING PORTIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2002, pursuant to Section 163.330 and as authorized by Section 163.410, Florida Statutes (the "Act"), by Resolution No. 2002-489.1, the City Council of Rockledge, Florida, designated itself as the governing body for the Community Redevelopment Agency and vested in the governing body all powers and duties, privileges and immunities vested in a Community Redevelopment Agency by the Act, pursuant to Section 163.357, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Rockledge City Council has determined it is in the best interests of the City of Rockledge and the Community Redevelopment Agency for the City Council to appoint an independent governing body as the Board of Commissioners of the Community Redevelopment Agency, pursuant to Section 163.356(2), Florida Statutes (2009), consisting of seven (7)

members who are not members of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLEDGE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 16, Article III, of the Rockledge Code of Ordinances is amended by deleting Section 16-18 and replacing it as follows:

SECTION 16-18 ROCKLEDGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

(1) Governing Body:

(a) Name: The governing body for the Rockledge Community Redevelopment Agency shall be known as the Rockledge Community Redevelopment Agency Board of Commissioners.

(b) Number of Commissioners: The Board of Commissioners shall consist of seven (7) Commissioners, none of whom shall be members of the Rockledge City Council.

(c) Initial Terms: The initial Commissioners shall be appointed to terms as follows:

1. One (1) member shall be appointed for a term of (1) year.
2. One (1) member shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years.
3. One (1) member shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years.
4. Four (4) members shall be appointed for a term of four (4) years.

These initial appointees shall serve from the date of appointment until the second City Council meeting in April after the passage of the appropriate number of years.

(d) Term: Other than the initial appointments per 16-18(1)(c), all subsequent terms of office of the Commissioners shall be for four (4) years after the initial appointments. All necessary appointments shall be made at the second City Council meeting in April.

(e) The City Council, by majority vote, shall appoint the individual Commissioners.

(f) A Commissioner shall receive no compensation for services, but is entitled to necessary expenses, including travel expenses incurred in discharge of duties.

(g) Each Commissioner shall hold office until his or her successor has been appointed and has been qualified.

(h) The City Council shall designate an initial Chair and Vice Chair from among the Commission members.

(i) The Commission shall nominate a Chair and Vice Chair from its membership at the first meeting in each New Year. Said nominations shall be referred to and subject to approval by the City Council.

(j) A person may be appointed as a Commissioner if he or she resides in or is engaged in a business within the City.

(k) The City Council may remove a Commissioner for

inefficiency, neglect of duty, or misconduct in office after a hearing and after the Commissioner has been given a copy of the charges at least ten (10) days prior to such hearing and has had an opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.


ABSENCES: Following appointment, any member who has three (3) consecutive unexcused absences (those not approved by the Chair prior to the meeting involved) or a total of four (4) absences during any 12-month period (excused or unexcused) shall automatically be terminated and removed as a member of the Commission.

SECTION 2. All provisions of Chapter 16, Article III, not amended by this ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or ineffective, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, it being expressly declared to be the City Council's intent that it would have passed the valid portions of this Ordinance without the inclusion therein of any invalid portion or portions.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days following its adoption and signed by the Chairman of the City Council.
